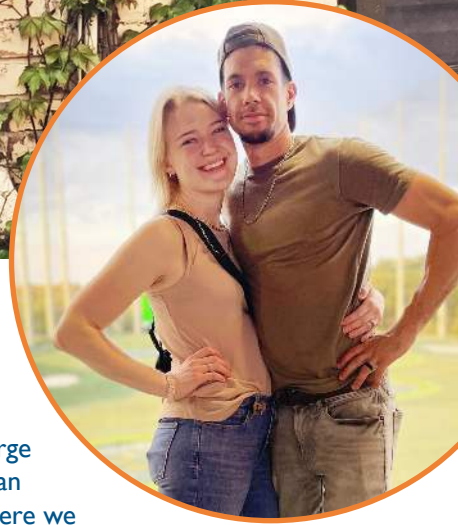


Jake & Hannah
