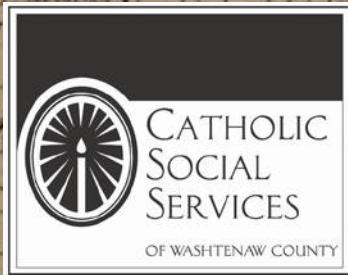
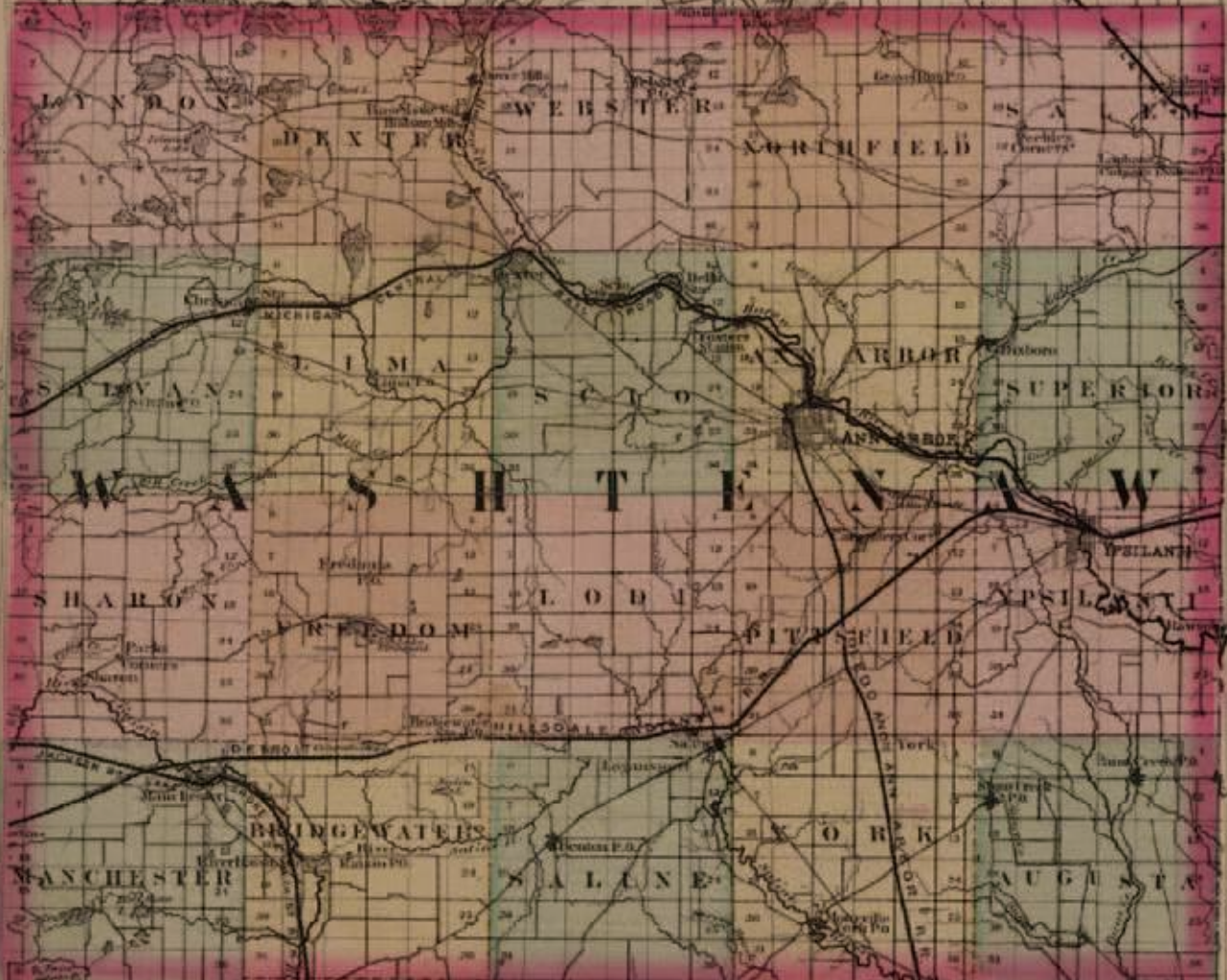

The Year in Review

“There is so much to do.”

Our community is many things: world-class academia, farmland, small town and city savvy, haute culture, blue-collar, white collar, multi-ethnic, the haves and the have-nots. We are not one-size-fits-all, and like the community we serve, Catholic Social Services of Washtenaw County's (CSSW) mission is diverse, distinct and determined.

Clearly, there is much to do.

CSSW has a long history of helping vulnerable individuals regardless of their age, religion or background. But we haven't stopped here. Our agency is moving forward to identify and remove the obstacles impeding a quality life for those subsisting in the margins. It is a considerable undertaking, but through our dedicated staff, volunteer team and colleagues, CSSW is up to the challenge:

- CSSW was awarded \$606,647 for 2011-2012 by the Washtenaw Coordinated Funders, a collaboration of the Office of Community Development (representing the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, and Washtenaw Urban County), the United Way of Washtenaw County, and the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation. The funding will support the following programs and focus areas: Aging, Early Childhood, Housing, and Safety Net Health and Nutrition.
- In October, volunteer Joseph McCadden was honored as “Michigan's Senior Volunteer of the Year” for his outstanding work on behalf of the agency's Tax Assistance program. Governor Rick Snyder presented McCadden the State's highest award for volunteerism. In the 16 years he has been at the agency, “Joe the Tax Man” has volunteered more than 1,400 hours to CSSW annually, helping more than 4,500 low-income seniors and disabled adults receive \$10 million back in tax refunds.
- In the past year, the CSSW Emergency Food program expanded its hours and established new services to help low-income families. In addition to providing non-perishable food and personal care items at no cost to thousands of local residents, the program now offers baby formula and Food Stamp application assistance.
- In 2011, CSSW formed partnerships with two community groups: Casa Latina and the Literacy Coalition of Washtenaw County.
- CSSW last summer hosted nine social work students from Shingu and Daejin Universities in South Korea. Likewise, through the University Of Michigan School of Social Work, the agency also welcomed two University of Hong Kong interns who, along with the Korean students, spent their time working at various agency programs.
- The annual RSVP Recognition event honored the more than 550 older adult volunteers who contributed nearly 69,000 hours of service to benefit local non-profit organizations.

Looking ahead, we are building on the successes of 2011. In January 2012, CSSW was awarded a highly competitive \$400,000 Social Innovation Fund sub-grant from the Corporation for Supportive Housing to participate in a demonstration project providing housing and coordinated health care to homeless adults. One of four pilot projects nationwide, the Washtenaw Frequent Users System Engagement (FUSE) program involves a county-wide coalition of 14 public and non-profit agencies.

CSSW could never do this alone, which is why we are grateful for our colleagues helping us serve the immediate and long-term needs of families in Washtenaw County. They are our partners, as are the agency's loyal supporters whose generosity of time and treasure enable CSSW to fulfill its mission.

There is much to do. With your belief in our efforts, we are well on our way.

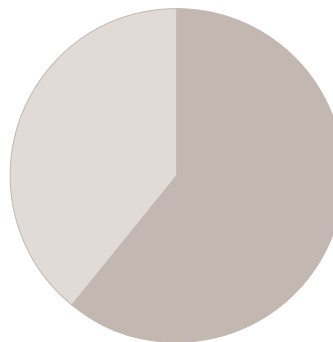

Nancy and Chris
Families First program



Nancy will tell you straight out she had a bad attitude. Actually, she was utterly out-of-control. A new mom at 17, the Jackson resident's erratic lifestyle—an explosive temper, personal recklessness, negligible parenting skills—did not create a stable environment for a newborn. "I didn't want to listen," she admits. "I didn't want somebody to tell me what I should be doing."

Shortly thereafter, Child Protective Services (CPS) was alerted and she was referred to the CSSW Families First program in Jackson. Nancy's bad attitude prevailed and she clearly was not willing to cooperate. Not long after, CPS intervened and her son was removed to ensure his safety. Nancy had two more babies by different dads within the next several years, and she relinquished custody of them as well. Life was not good.

"My whole life is better."

In 2010, after she gave birth to a baby girl named Caroline, Nancy and her fiancé Chris were ecstatic. Their excitement was short-lived, however, when the hospital refused to release the baby to her custody. Ultimately, Chris was granted guardianship under the condition they both participate in Families First. This time, Nancy was ready to listen. To change. To become the kind of mother Caroline needs and deserves.

"We do whatever it takes to get our families on the right track," explains Cathi Kelley, Families First program director. "We make sure they go to parenting classes or substance abuse counseling; we help fix up their homes. You name it, our workers are there."

Nancy and Chris agree. When their case was referred to the program last year, Nancy shelved the belligerence and, with the guidance by Families First, established clear, achievable goals. She attended parenting classes and psychotherapy to develop better coping strategies; Chris voluntarily signed up for the Community Action Agency's Proud Fathers program. Now married, both committed to providing a safe, stable and loving home for Caroline.

"I'm so glad I did this," Nancy confirms. "My whole life is better."

There is much to do ...

2011 Agency Highlights

Counseling/Marriage Preparation

- In its first year, the Recovery After an Initial Schizophrenia Episode (RAISE) Early Treatment Program exceeded its recruitment goal by 50 percent
- The number of couples enrolled in We C.A.R.E. marriage preparation classes grew by 17 percent from the previous year

Senior Services

- "The Oaks" Adult Day Services program noted a sizable increase in clients experiencing mental health problems in addition to adults with memory impairments
- The Interfaith Volunteer Caregivers program provided 1,740 hours of respite care for 38 families caring for a chronically ill older adult
- The Medicare/Medicaid Assistance program (MMAP) counseled 749 clients, enabling clients to save thousands annually in Medicare expenses
- Neighborhood Senior Services assisted 477 older adults last year, an increase of 28 percent. Included in the wide range of services were home repairs, substance and elder abuse screenings, and medical transportation, resulting in 91 percent of clients reporting a greater sense of safety and security
- RSVP volunteers donated more than 69,000 hours of service to 83 local non-profit agencies
- Tax Assistance volunteers enabled more than 1,000 clients to receive \$630,000 in tax refunds and credits



Parenting

- The Family Time (supervised parenting/exchange) program grew 80 percent from 148 to 267 clients. Both custodial and non-custodial parents reported an increased sense of safety while participating in the program

Parenting, cont.

- Grandparents as Parents successfully recruited new participants from outlying Washtenaw County communities
- Ninety-five percent of families in the Healthy Families program were free from abuse and neglect, connected to a primary physician, and had their children up-to-date on their immunizations



Pregnancy/Adoption

- Due to the program's respected reputation, Adoption Services is the first referral source of local hospitals, physicians and agencies
- Eighty percent of the pregnant and parenting teens at the Father Patrick Jackson House increased their income and educational attainment, helping to ensure a stable transition to independent living
- Every Pregnancy Counseling client who completed an adoption plan reported receiving a complete and comprehensive education on their rights and responsibilities



Community Living Support (Food, Health & Housing)

- The Emergency Food program distributed more than 30,000 pounds of food each month to help 1,671 households who reported an annual income just above \$3,100
- The average tenancy for Housing Support Services clients was 2.3 years. These results are significant because vulnerable adults in the program are at extremely high risk of homelessness
- In its first year of operation, the HVA Patient Advocacy program received 21 referrals resulting in a 77 percent decrease in ambulance runs
- Intentional Communities of Washtenaw, a sustainable housing community for adults with disabilities, doubled the number of members living independently by opening a new site at Woodchase apartments in Ann Arbor
- Upon completion of their required participation, many clients in the Alternatives to Domestic Aggression RENEW program for women return to seek additional support.
- The Washtenaw Child Advocacy Center expanded its services to serve parents in addition to sexually abused children, resulting in an 81 percent increase in clients



RSVP Volunteers: Pittsfield Senior Quilters



Once a week, more than 20 RSVP program volunteers meet at the Pittsfield Senior Center quilting blankets, pillows, caps, scarves, gift baskets, helmet liners, and fabric walker bags. Here's the kicker: They don't keep a single item for themselves.

The Pittsfield Senior Quilters, a group started 13 years ago by retired Home Economics teacher Mary Sougstad, donates everything they make—more than 1,500 quilts a year alone—to a variety of folks including children at Mott Hospital, convalescent center residents, homebound seniors from St. Francis of Assisi, Father Patrick Jackson House families, and even U.S. Army service members. Each design is unique, made by a volunteer who spends hours creating and sewing their own work. Made meticulously with care, it is appreciated.

A recipient of the President's Volunteer Service Award, Mary welcomes quilters at all levels of experience, noting that all the materials are provided free of charge. Like the excellent teacher she was, she instructs, actively encourages and, most importantly, makes the experience fun and meaningful for each of the members.

Thousands of quilts, hats and scarves later, the group has certainly come a long way. Mary and her fellow quilters embody the spirit of RSVP volunteerism by making life a bit warmer, one blanket at a time.

There is much to do ...

Community

When you face a challenge, you do what works. For Catholic Social Services of Washtenaw County, what works is standing as a cohesive team to identify and respond to the hardships of local families. Yet we do not walk alone in our mission to help our neighbors in the most difficult of circumstances. We are part of a community, working with our colleagues in the non-profit and public sectors to empower vulnerable families to turn their lives around.

- **Blueprint for Aging**

CSSW provides coordination and planning for the the Blueprint for Aging—a collaborative of seniors, nonprofits, businesses, and local government working to improve the services, care, and quality of life for older adults in Washtenaw County. Established to respond to the rapidly growing demographic of older adults, the Blueprint convenes stakeholders to understand community issues, and creates and tests innovative system changes that make Washtenaw County a great place to live and age.

- **Intentional Communities of Washtenaw (ICW)**

A program of Catholic Social Services, ICW is an association of parents and concerned citizens dedicated to creating sustainable housing communities for disabled individuals regardless of their race, religion or ability to pay. The program promotes supported housing options enabling adults with disabilities to thrive in a dignified, productive and independent community setting.

- **Michigan Prison Re-entry (MPR)**

CSSW works in Washtenaw and Livingston counties to reduce crime by implementing a seamless service and supervision plan developed with each client from the time of their entry into prison through their release and reintegration into society.

- **Washtenaw Child Advocacy Center (WCAC)**

A child-focused program where the Michigan Department of Human Services, Washtenaw County Prosecutor's office, local law enforcement agencies, mental health and medical professionals, and victims' advocates work together to conduct forensic interviews and make team decisions about the investigation, treatment, and prosecution of child sexual abuse cases. The program helps minimize the trauma to children and families by offering crisis intervention services, coordinated case management and emotional support as the case goes through the legal system.

- **Washtenaw Housing Alliance (WHA)**

The WHA is comprised of more than two dozen non-profit organizations providing shelter, housing, and supportive services for those who are homeless or at high risk of homelessness. In addition to CSSW, this extraordinary collaboration harnesses the commitment, energy and resources of the private sector, a major hospital system, the Cities of Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti, Washtenaw County, three institutions of higher learning, and the community at large.

Play on, Norman Bowers

Member of The Oaks ~ Adult Day Services

Norman Bowers started playing the violin 86 years ago. The violin was a gift from his mother, which he played at his church and later in the junior high school band. For family and friends, at social gatherings and retirement homes, Norman continued entertaining others throughout his adulthood. He loves it to this day, almost as much as those appreciating his *joie de vivre* flowing from each note he plays.

You might reasonably believe he would tire of performing. After all, when he first picked up the violin, Calvin Coolidge led a country of 115 million and Winnie-the-Pooh was a brand new kid's book. Radio was in its infancy, movies didn't talk and the idea of space travel or the internet would have been the stuff of H.G. Wells. Yet play on, he does.

Norman started coming to The Oaks~ Adult Day Services several years ago, after his wife Laura died and he moved in with his nephew and family. Now 95 and legally blind, he performs at The Oaks each Friday along with several volunteers who play the piano and harp.

"I thank God for coming here (to The Oaks). Everyone is so friendly, and I still get to play, though I can't see the music anymore since I lost my sight to glaucoma about a year ago," Norman explains.

He might not have the stamina to stand very long while playing, and reading music is no longer an option. Nevertheless, he still knows how to hold an audience. Play on, Norman Bowers. You're an inspiration to us all.

Brunch at the Big House

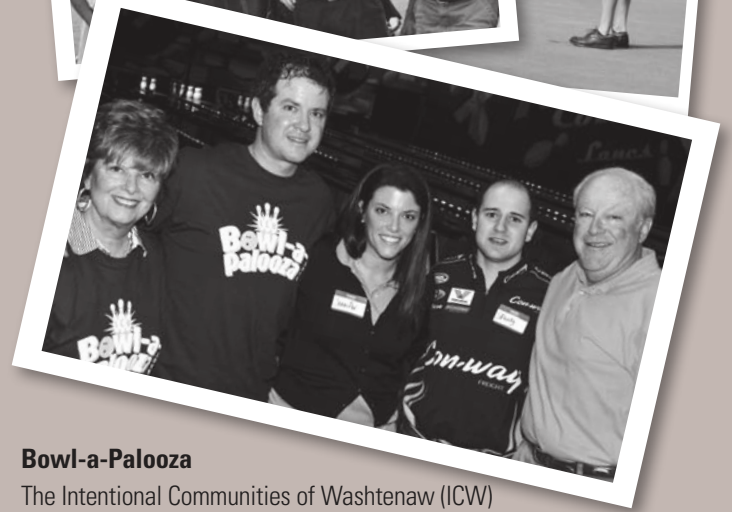

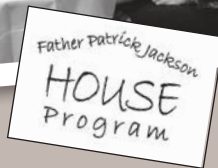


Bowl-a-Palooza

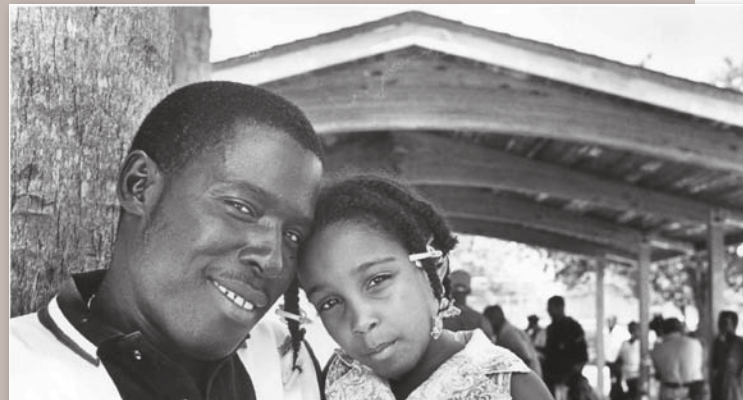

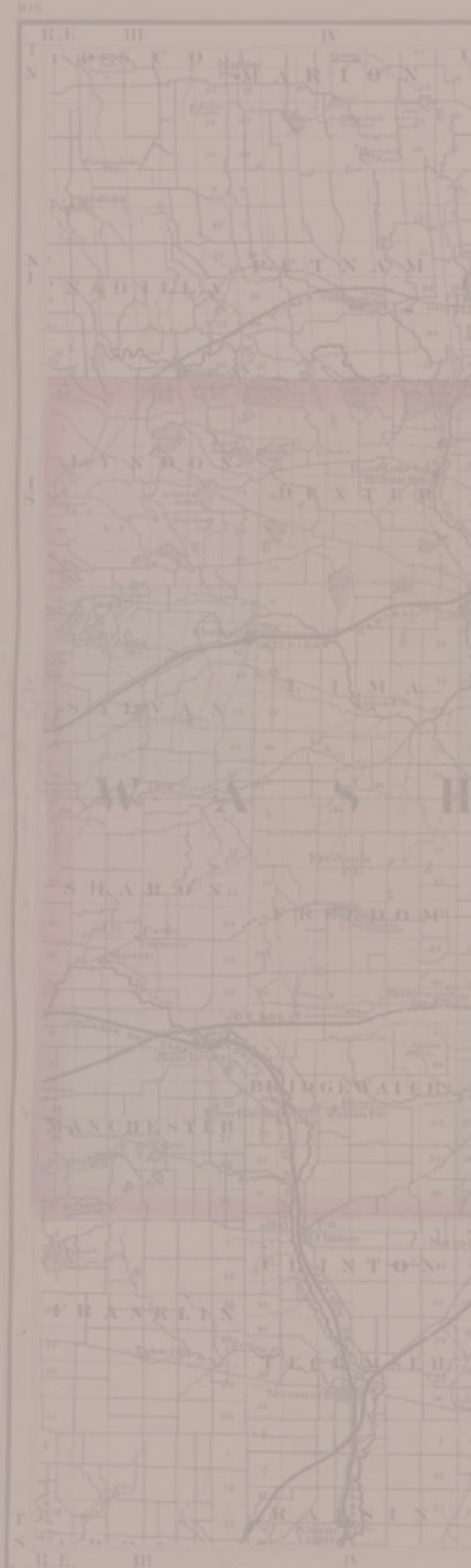

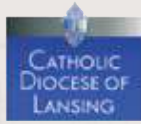
