Improves the lives of our community's most vulnerable citizens and has been providing help since 1959. The Agency serves more than 8,000 individuals and families annually, with 85% non-Catholic. More than two-thirds of CSSW clients report annual incomes below \$15,000 and represent 50% of the poorest members in our community.

Offers more than two dozen programs to address a wide range of critical social problems and to help families at all stages of life—including food assistance, mental health treatment, substance abuse group therapy, domestic violence and child abuse prevention, adoption and pregnancy counseling, and services for frail elders and at-risk families.

Brings together local stakeholders to focus on our community's most challenging issues such as quality of life for our aging population, prisoner reentry, and child sexual abuse.
