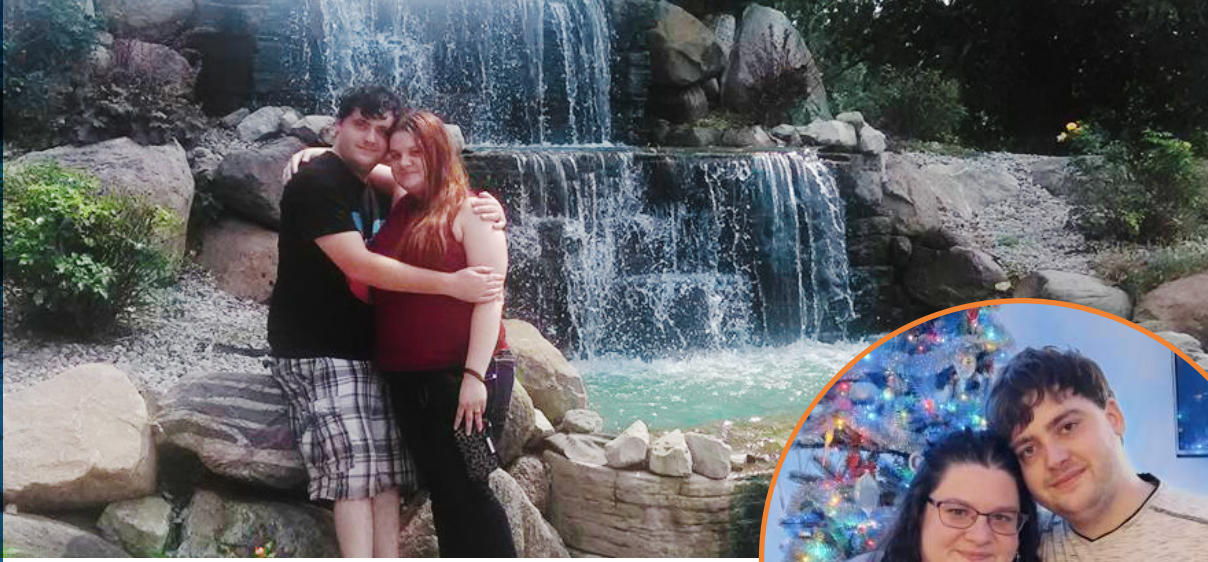


# Reed & Jenifer
